Ways of Working are Changing: Workspaces Must Also Adapt to Digital Innovations

Successful digital transformation involves not only technological investments but also cultural shifts.

How we work has changed, and the places we work in must change with it. As teams do more collaborative work, we must create spaces that encourage this transition.

Building Borderless and Connected Workspaces

The Workplace of the Future Fosters Collaboration

Physical proximity is no longer the default mode for teams to work together. Connected workspaces have become a necessity to facilitate collaboration whenever it is needed, in the office or remotely.

According to research by M Moser Associates, an East Asian architecture and design studio, 83% of surveyed employees envision the future office to have spaces for team building or socialising. Up to 74% want offices with areas dedicated to collaborative work.⁶

While nine out of 10 knowledge workers⁷ believe digital collaboration is here to stay, 49% still believe collaboration is easier in-person⁸ or at the office. Companies must provide flexible, open and interactive spaces to encourage collaboration in physical workplaces.

Paving a Way Forward

Digital transformation initiatives tend to fail or stall when companies don't accompany tech investments with changes in work models, work culture and skills.⁹

Experts have a number of recommendations:

1. Upgrade Your IT Infrastructure

How people connect at work and outside the office is critical in keeping things running smoothly. Digitalising your workspace and workflows will facilitate this connection. Embrace cloud technology.

Shift your data storage to the cloud to collaborate beyond the physical office and even across borders.

If data leaks are your concern, the top cloud service providers have high security and authentication protocols that can keep your business data safe.

Working from the cloud also makes your business much more scalable, as allocating new cloud resources is faster than buying and setting up hardware.



Invest in collaboration software.

Many cloud-based platforms enable seamless cross-team and cross-border communication.

For hybrid workplaces, having the right collaboration software can help make your employees more effective and efficient.

Online collaborative spaces also encourage rich, cross-cultural exchanges and foster innovation. Your next business idea or product may come from an online brainstorming session.

2. Upskill Your Workforce

The most successful companies invest in their people. Up to 58% of APAC employees consider digital skills important to their careers.¹⁰ Helping your people gain relevant skills will bring dividends not just to employees, but also to your business.



Support your employees in learning new skills related to AI, process automation and other emerging technologies.

Always have them put on a lens of how these skills can improve their jobs or streamline processes.



Some businesses have created **internal boot camps** where employees work together to build process automation that relieves known pain points in the office.

This not only builds employee skills; the application of those skills also helps boost work efficiency.

3. Foster Open Communication

People may have great ideas but may be afraid to share them. Encouraging employees to make suggestions and be open to change is a great way to transform your workplace from the inside out.



Gartner's Senior Director Analyst for Manufacturing, Ivar Berntz, recommends giving people more autonomy over day-to-day processes, enabling them to try new ways of doing things.

This also means giving them more responsibility for the results,¹¹ breeding a sense of intrapreneurship within the business.

Fostering a culture of innovation within your organisation encourages open collaboration and feedback. It helps ensure bottom-up suggestions are heard and valued, leaving more opportunities to identify and address areas for improvement.

Transformation in Action: Toray Asia

Singapore-based Toray Asia Pte Ltd (TAS) is a wholly-owned subsidiary of leading chemical manufacturer Toray Industries, Inc., which specialises in manufacturing, processing and selling synthetic fibres.

To serve its ever-growing regional client base, TAS employees must be mobile. They often work remotely on their laptops, smartphones and tablets. Uploading documents or contracts to the office server is part of their routine.

In the old way of working, these documents had to be printed and filed as hard copies for reference. For uniformity, documents were sometimes re-typed to keep everything the same paper size. This added needless manual work hours to already busy days.



The workplace transformation at TAS began with **equipping employees with mobile printing and scanning**. Employees could copy, scan and send documents securely with a tap of their mobile devices.

Through built-in cloud on-demand print capabilities, employees can print from any computer or mobile device, even when outside the office.



The administrative process of document reformatting was eliminated with **software that converted scanned documents seamlessly into editable Word and Excel files** before uploading, saving employees time.



Managing, sorting and accessing documents on the go was also made possible by a cloud-based application that enabled more efficient document searching and editing.

Now, whenever an order request is received, TAS can respond promptly by checking the necessary information, preparing a proposal and distributing it to a sales representative, who can present the proposal on the spot with a tablet or smartphone. Documents can also be annotated and shared for more efficient collaboration.

With the right technological solutions, TAS was able to streamline work processes and enable seamless coordination from wherever their employees may be. This helped TAS cover more ground in less time, growing its business in the region.

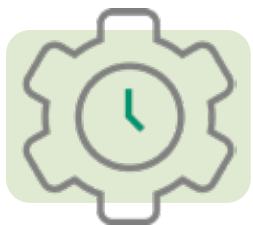

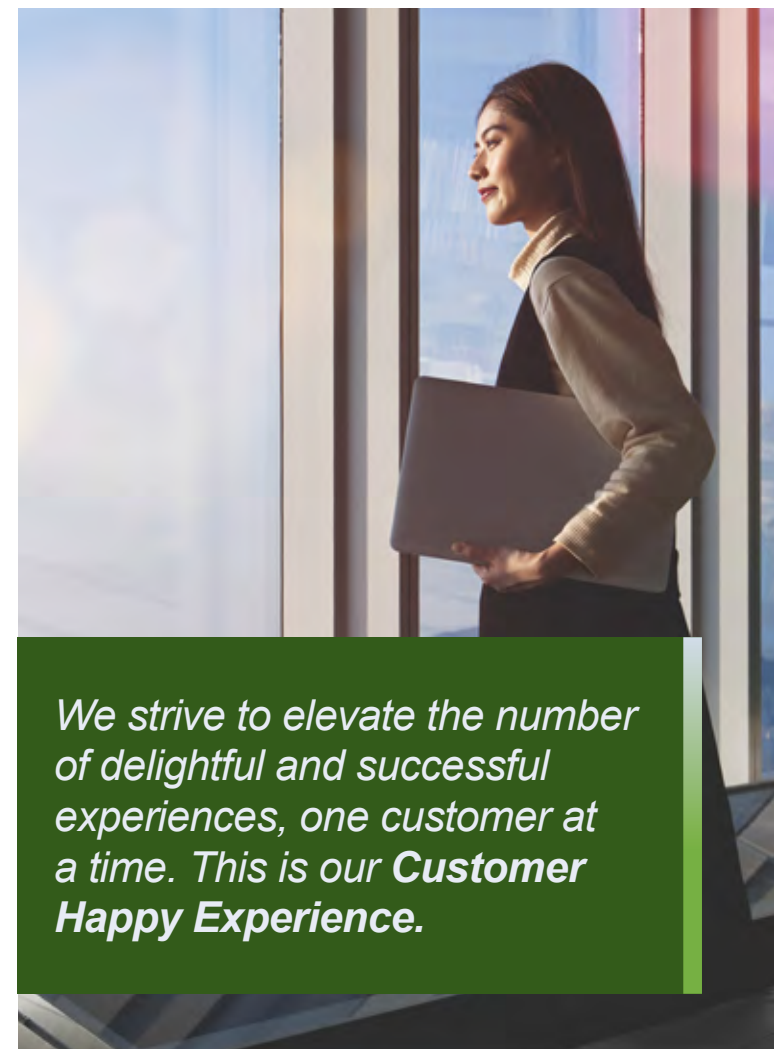
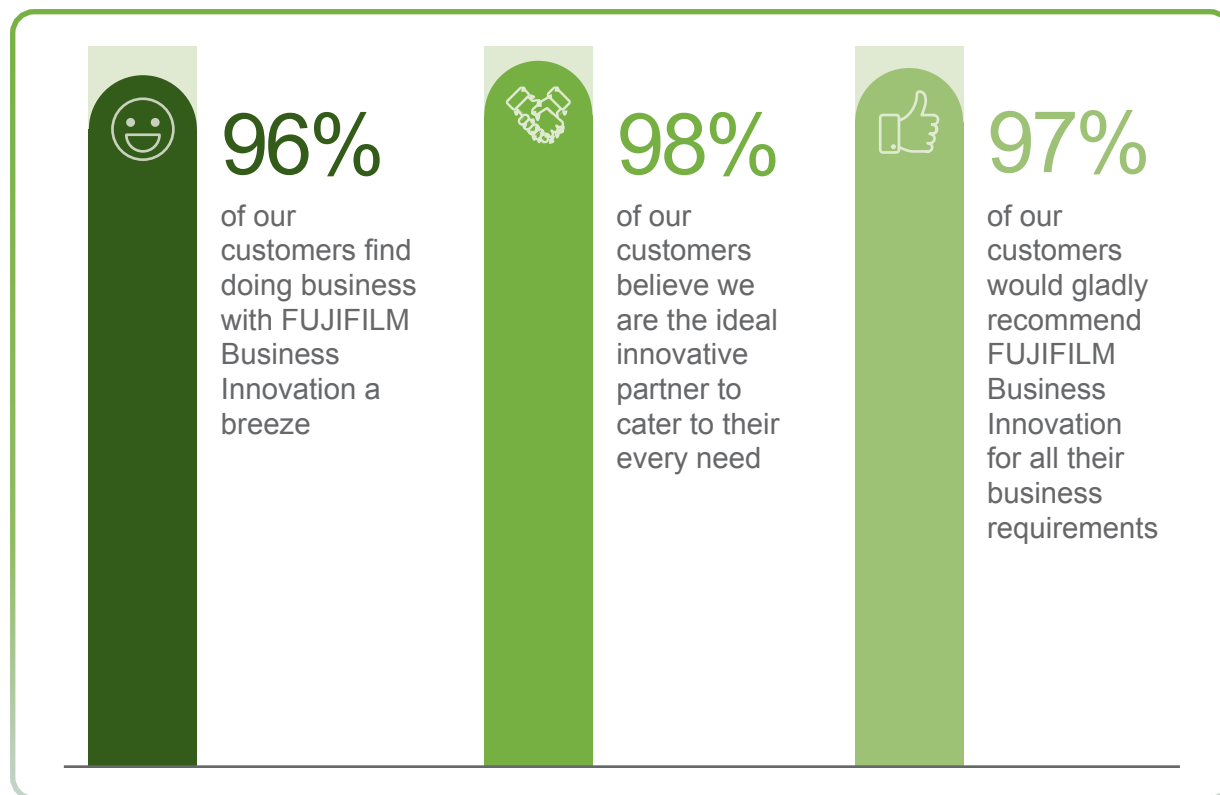
