

LRQA Independent Assurance Statement

Relating to Fujifilm Holdings Corporation's Environmental Data with the FUJIFILM Sustainability Report 2026 for the fiscal year 2025

This Assurance Statement has been prepared for *Fujifilm Holdings Corporation* in accordance with our contract.

Terms of Engagement

LRQA was commissioned by *Fujifilm Holdings Corporation* to provide independent assurance on *its environmental data* within its *Sustainability Report 2026* ("the report") for the 2026, that is, from 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026, against the assurance criteria below to a limited level of assurance at the materiality of the professional judgement of the verifier and using ISAE 3000 (Revised) and ISO 14064 - Part 3:2019 for GHG emissions.

Our assurance engagement covered *Fujifilm Holdings Corporation's* operations and activities in Japan and overseas (including those of its 253 consolidated subsidiaries) and specifically the following requirements:

- Verifying conformance with the Company's reporting methodologies in accordance with the GHG Protocol for the selected dataset; and
- Evaluating the accuracy and reliability of data for only the selected indicators listed below:

Environmental¹

- Scope 1 GHG emissions² (ktCO₂e)
- Scope 2 GHG emissions³ (market-based and location-based) (ktCO₂e)
- Scope 3 GHG emissions associated with Categories 1-3, 5-8, 11, 13-15⁴ (ktCO₂e)
- Total water intake⁵ and total wastewater discharge⁵ (thousand m³)
- Total waste emissions⁶ (thousand tonnes)
- Fluorocarbon emissions (PFC, CFC, HCFC, HFC)

Our assurance engagement excluded the data and information of the Company's suppliers, contractors and any third parties mentioned in the report.

LRQA's responsibility is only to the Company. LRQA disclaims any liability or responsibility to others as explained in the end footnote. the Company's responsibility is for collecting, aggregating, analysing and presenting all the data

² Activities subject to fluorocarbon reporting do not include emissions from the installation of new refrigeration/freezing equipment or from disposal-related leaks. Moreover, data from FUJIFILM Manufacturing Precision Products (Shenzhen) Corp., FUJIFILM Wako Bio Solutions Corporation and some Japanese and international sales branches are excluded. Data from consolidated subsidiaries with fewer than 10 employees are excluded.

and information within the Report and for maintaining effective internal controls over the systems from which the Report is derived. Ultimately, the Report has been approved by, and remains the responsibility of the Company.

LRQA's Opinion

Based on LRQA's approach nothing has come to our attention that would cause us to believe that the Company has not, in all material respects:

- Met the requirements of the criteria listed above; and
- Disclosed accurate and reliable environmental data as summarized in Table 1.

The opinion expressed is formed on the basis of a limited level of assurance⁷ and at the materiality of the professional judgement of the verifier.

LRQA's Approach

LRQA's assurance engagements are carried out in accordance with ISAE 3000 (Revised) and ISO 14064-3. The following tasks were undertaken as part of the evidence gathering process for this assurance engagement:

- Auditing the Company's data management systems to confirm that there were no significant errors, omissions or misstatements in the report. We did this by reviewing the effectiveness of data handling procedures, instructions and systems, including those for internal verification.
- Interviewing with those key people responsible for compiling the data and drafting the report.
- Sampling datasets and traced activity data back to aggregated levels;
- Verifying the historical data and records for the fiscal year 2025; and
- Visiting Fujifilm Material Manufacturing Co.'s Kyushu Plant (FFMT Kyushu) and Fujifilm Manufacturing Corporation's Takematsu Plant to confirm the data collection processes, record management practices, and physically check evidence.

Observations

Further observations and findings, made during the assurance engagement, are:

- It is recommended the Company will continue to maintain the high-level data management systems and discover further improvement opportunities proactively to ensure accurate aggregation and calculation of environmental data.

LRQA's Standards, Competence and Independence

LRQA implements and maintains a comprehensive management system that meets accreditation requirements for ISO 14065 *Greenhouse gases – Requirements for greenhouse gas validation and verification bodies for use in accreditation or other forms of recognition* and ISO/IEC 17021-1 *Conformity assessment – Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems – Part1: Requirements* that are at least as demanding as the requirements of the International Standard on Quality Control 1 and comply with the *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants* issued by the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants.

LRQA ensures the selection of appropriately qualified individuals based on their qualifications, training and experience. The outcome of all verification and certification assessments is then internally reviewed by senior management to ensure that the approach applied is rigorous and transparent.

⁷ The extent of evidence-gathering for a limited assurance engagement is less than for a reasonable assurance engagement. Limited assurance engagements focus on aggregated data rather than physically checking source data at sites. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed.

LRQA is the Company's certification body for ISO9001, and ISO14001. The verification and certification assessments are the only work undertaken by LRQA for the Company, and as such does not compromise our independence or impartiality.
